UNDISCOVERED UNESCO-PEARL

Lviv, Lwow, Lwów, Lemberg, Leopoldis - translated Lion's city - the city has so many names and so many faces. A cultural pleasure and formerly the fourth largest city in the Habsburg monarchy. Lviv is a cultural metropolis in western Ukraine with multinational traditions, an architectural gem that was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1998.

Lviv has a beautiful ancient UNESCO city center and is an undiscovered pearl in Galicia, today's western Ukraine. Close to Budapest and Kraków, this tourist destination is an insider tip for your next city break! Lviv is the absolute cultural capital of and festival capital of Ukraine. Treat yourself to the unique experience with the enchanting charm of the city center - sometimes arranged, sometimes improvised, sometimes danceable, but always live and with a real piece of history.



Throughout the year there are special events that are worth visiting the Cultural Capital of Ukraine. There are festivals on the one hand, then trade fairs, coffee, beer and gourmet tours, congresses, religious holidays such as Christmas and Easter with special customs and traditions etc. In addition, concerts with popular and classical music give the city its unforgettable charm.

KYIV - THE CAPITAL OF UKRAINE

Kyiv is a vibrant metropolis in gold and green, the capital not only of Ukraine, but historically also of the Kyivan Rus' - a former East Slavic empire - and the sanctuary of the Orthodox religion.

The old and at the same time young city of Kyiv combines not only the millennial traditions, rich cultural heritage, ancient architecture and historical sights, but also the highly developed infrastructure and fast pace of life of a modern Eastern European metropolis with over 3 million inhabitants on both banks of the Dnipro (Dnepr) river.

Kyiv offers numerous opportunities for a varied and interesting sightseeing program, and is an ideal place for organizing all kinds of MICE events.

BOOMING METROPOLIS ON THE DNIPRO



IDEAS FOR SIGHTSEEING AND EXCURSIONS IN KYIV AND IN THE AREA:

- Excursion to one of the largest open air museums in Europe - Pyrohovo
- Adventurous trip to Chernobyl (including overnight stay possible!)
- Visit to the former presidential villa with anti-corruption museum Boat tour on the Dnipro (also possible with lunch or dinner on board!)
- Kyivan Rus Park (a unique opportunity to see what Kyiv looked like at the beginning and in its prime)
- Trip to the castle museum in Radomyshl (with the world's only museum of household icons!)

HIGHLIGHTS OF KYIV:

- The Kyiv-Pechersk Lavra cave monastery is one of the oldest Orthodox monasteries of the Kyivan Rus
- The oldest church in Kyiv - St. Sophia Cathedral (UNESCO World Heritage Site)
 - Symbols of the revolutions - Khreshchatyk Street and Independence Square (Maidan)
 - Golden Gate - the mighty entrance to the city from the time of Yaroslav the Wise
 - Andriyivskyy Descent - Montmartre of Kyiv - with the St. Andrew baroque church and numerous street cafes and art galleries

ODESSA AND THE DANUBE DELTA

Odessa - its sounds like music, like a beautiful melody! It enchants every visitor. This port city on the Black Sea is truly a pearl that shines in its own past and present. The city is glamorous and at the same time shabby, funny, sensual and always exciting. A city break in Odessa is something special for young and old.

To the south of Odessa is the Ukrainian Venice - Vylkove, the gateway to the Danube Delta World Natural Heritage, once only populated by Old Ritualists (Lipovans). Not much has changed today and tourism has remained authentic in this part of the delta. Vylkove looks "exotic" - almost half of the area includes channels, which are crossed by many wooden bridges and alleys. Boats are still the main form of transportation here today.



PEARL ON THE BLACK SEA



In the whole World, Danube makes the only exception with the beginning of its length measurement at its mouth. "0th km vs 2857th km" is the starting and ending point of the Danube. Before getting here it has passed through 13 states, a wide variety of cultures and histories. More than 300 species of birds, some of them rare, are constantly romping around or passing through the delta region. Six bird migration routes cross here and it is the largest resting area for migratory birds. Albatrosses, herons, white-tailed eagles and ospreys, 7000 pink pelicans and many more are waiting for you - sitting, swimming and flying in the air!

- Odessa port as a symbol of the city, legendary Potemkin's stairs, Odessa Opera House, Primorskyi Boulevard and De Ribas Promenade, Odessa Catacombs, Privoz Market, Shustov Cognac Museum, countless beaches and pubs along the sea coast.
- Ship voyage with an excursion boat on the Black Sea • Danube Delta "0th km" - one of the last natural paradises in Europe • Folklore night on the Danube with fish specialties • Snake Island (Zmiyinyi) - an absolute insiders' tip for nature lovers • Akkermann fortress and Shabo winery
